The Chairman of the Council made his report and referred to the following: -

- Litter pickers – it was agreed to purchase litter pickers.
- Dog Fouling – it was agreed to put signs up to tackle the problem.
- The Thatch – an update was requested and the Chair said that he would get further information
- Defibrillator – it was agreed to purchase new pads

352 BOROUGH COUNCILLOR'S REPORT

Cllr Davies attended the meeting and updated Members on issues affecting Cheshire East Council.

- Cllr Davies reported that he had been onto Cheshire East Council about safety issues on the bends between Faddiley Bank Lane and Hollywell Farm and reported that there may be some

movement on this issue.

- Junction with Cuckoo Lane – it was reported that a number of accidents had taken place at this location and information from Cheshire East is that work will begin at the site in the near future. A number of plans are being considered using s106 monies and these include changes to Monks Lane.

Cllr Davies announced that he would not be standing at the next election and the Parish Council thanked him for his service and wished him well.
